- **Religion**

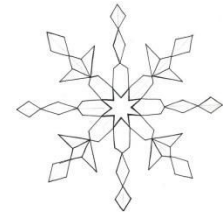
We will begin memorize the Angel of God prayer while finishing up our Call to Faith Chapters.
