- **Religion**

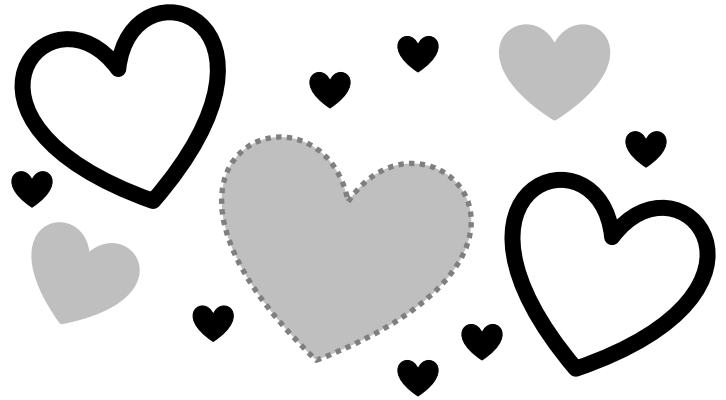
We will talk this month about the love Jesus has for us and what it means to be a follower of Jesus. We will also begin learning Hail Mary this month.
