Dear Parents,

During this Lenten season, we will help you child better understand the meaning of Lent. We will discuss how we can pray, fast, and give alms in special ways during this season. We will teach students how to prepare ourselves during Lent to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus. Lent is a special time for families to set aside time for family prayer, attend Sunday Mass, Stations of the Cross, or a weekday Mass. Sacred Heart School attends liturgy every Wednesday at 8:30 a.m. Parents are welcome to join us as we celebrate the Eucharist together on Wednesdays. Lent is a good time to reflect on the unity of Christians in light of our common joy in the Resurrection. Together we can help your child grow to cherish this unity.

Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held **Tuesday, March 26**, and **Thursday, March 28**, from **3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** In order to make your conference a profitable one, we would like to suggest some things you may want to ask about and some things you may want to tell the teacher.

You may want to ask the teacher:

1. Does my child participate in class?
2. Does my child demonstrate self-control?
3. How does my child get along with other children?
4. Does my child seem happy in school?

You may want to tell the teacher:

1. Which school activities your child talks about at home.
2. If anything has happened lately at home/school that might affect your child's performance.
3. What are your child's strengths and weaknesses?

Sharing information about your child with his/her teacher will enable us to provide a learning program that will best meet the needs of your child.

Kindergarten Registration will be held on **Tuesday, March 12**, at **6:00 p.m.** We invite families with children who are eligible for kindergarten for the 2019-2020 school. There will be a short presentation, tour of the school, meet the principal and teachers, ask questions, and visit with current Sacred Heart parents. Don't miss this opportunity. All are welcome!

Kindergarten Immunizations are required for all children enrolling in the fall. State immunization laws require children to have a series of three hepatitis B shots, chicken pox immunization, and MMR, DTP, and Pollo boosters. **Students will not be admitted the first day of school without documentation of immunization proof.**
