Dear Parents,

As parent or guardian you are called to sow the seeds of faith in your child. Registration for the 2019-2020... Please find the attached registration forms for the 2019-2020 school year. The school must request and update these forms annually. The registration fee for the upcoming school year is \$200 per family. Registration information and fees are due by Friday, May 17, 2019. It is important that all information be returned by the due date so program planning can begin for the 2019-2020 school year.

Kindergarten Immunizations... Immunizations are required for all children enrolling in the fall. State immunization laws require children to have a series of three hepatitis B shots, chicken pox immunization, and MMR, DTP, and Pollo boosters. **Students will not be admitted the first day of school without documentation of immunization proof**.

Preschool Screening... Preschool screening is required for all incoming kindergarten students. The Family Education Center will be screening students this spring during the month of May. Please contact the ECFE Office at 835-2222 to set up an appointment for your child.

First Holy Communion...Our second grade students will celebrate First Holy Communion on Sunday, May 5, at 10:00 a.m. Please remember these students in your prayers as they continue to grow in love and understanding of the Lord.

Grandparents' Day...Mark your calendar!!! Sacred Heart School will celebrate Grandparents' Day on Wednesday, May 15, 2019. An invitation with details will be sent later this month.
