- **Religion**

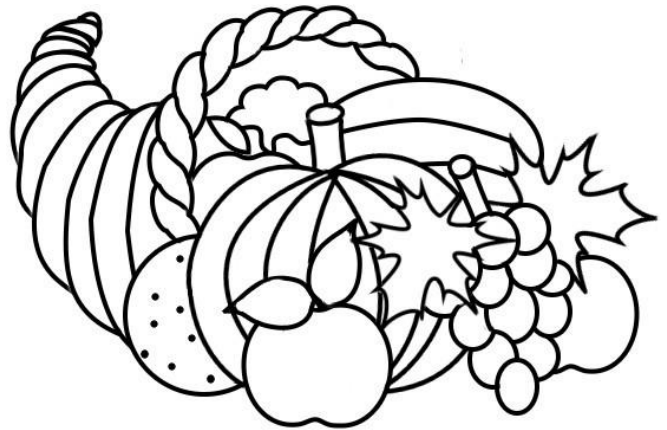
In November the students will begin memorizing the Our Father prayer. Please take time to discuss the role prayer plays in your life with your child.
