- **Math**

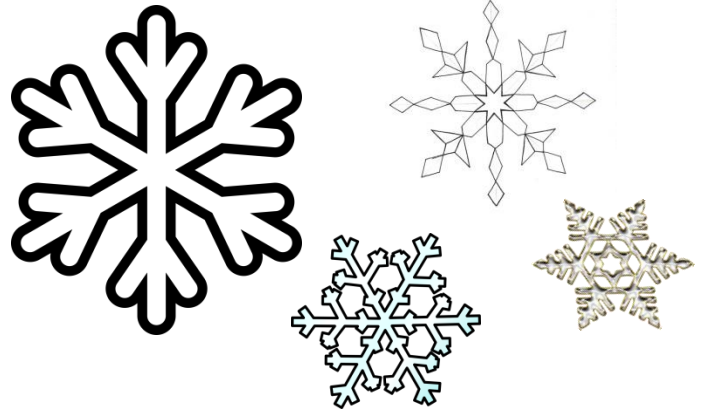
January is the month for more graphing and addition, the introduction of subtraction, and discussing the attributes of shapes. Please continue to practice counting to 120 with your child at home.
