In class this month....

Literacy: Students continue to work on concepts including antonyms, synonyms, metaphors, similes, prefixes, suffixes, and spelling. This month we also explored writing skills including using dialogue, fixing run-on sentences, and writing for clarity. Our personal narratives are over halfway done with just one more section to write and edit. Students also learned about haiku poetry as part of our spooky Halloween themed art project.

Math: Our focus in math has continued to be basic math facts, multi-digit, multiplication, and word problem work. We have been doing reasoning problems which help us decide what the problem is asking of us.
