- **Math**

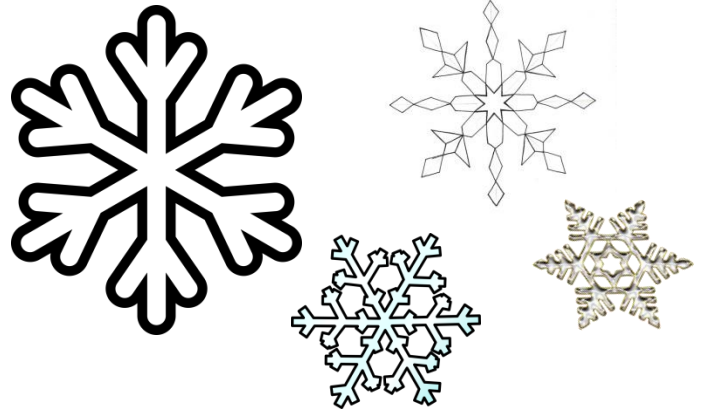
January is the month for more graphing and counting, the introduction of addition, and discussing the attributes of shapes. Please continue to practice counting to 120 with your child at home.
