In class this month....

Language Arts: With a new focus on writing, students are hard at work on their realistic fiction stories. We have continued our discussions on latin/greek roots, identifying parts of speech, and verb conjugation.

Math: This month we completed Unit 5 which focused on adding and subtracting fractions. We have also focused heavily on conceptualizing word problems by asking "what should I do with these numbers?".

Science: With an electrifying finish, we ended our physical science unit with magnets, types of waves and forces of motion. Next, we will dive into a microscopic world of life science!

Social Studies: Students learned about the history of the United States. We followed a timeline from the 13 colonies to today. Students also explored elements of both the revolutionary and civil wars. We ended this discussion with a geography quiz identifying the location of the 50 states on a map!
