What We're Up To:

Language Arts: We are exploring biographies and how people can make a difference. Our phonics lessons will focus on open and closed syllables, prefixes and suffixes, and words with silent letters. Our grammar lessons will focus on comparative and superlative adjectives, commas, and pronouns.

Math: This month we will continue working on addition with missing addend problems (ex. $14 + \underline{\quad} = 20$) and adding three or four numbers. We will also be exploring more units of measurement and shapes.

Religion: As we continue our preparation for the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, we will dive deeper into these chapters in the Call to Faith curriculum.

Science: Our science unit this month is called *Patterns in the Sky*. In this unit we will learn about weather, planets, moon phases, the sun, and stars.
