REGISTRATION ...Registration information for the 2021-2022 school year was sent with the March newsletters for all students K-3rd grade. Please complete one form for each child. SHARP...Our plan is to reopen SHARP for the 2021-2022 school year. Registration forms and SHARP Handbook may be found on the school website at www.sacredheartschoolwaseca.com. At this time we plan to provide service before school beginning at 7:30 a.m. and after school until 5:00 p.m. There is a \$25.00 registration fee. The cost for SHARP is \$3.50 per hour/per child. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION...Our second grade students will celebrate First Holy Communion on Sunday, April 18, at 10:00 a.m. Please remember these children in your prayers so they continue to grow in love and understanding of the Lord.

KINDERGARTEN IMMUNIZATIONS...Kindergarten students entering in the fall are required by state immunization laws to have the series of three hepatitis B shots, chicken pox immunization, and MMR, DTP, and Polio boosters. **Students will not be admitted the first day of school without documentation of immunization proof.**
