- **Religion**

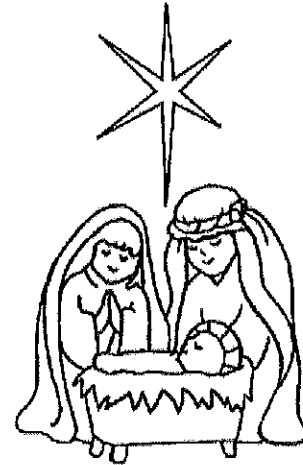
