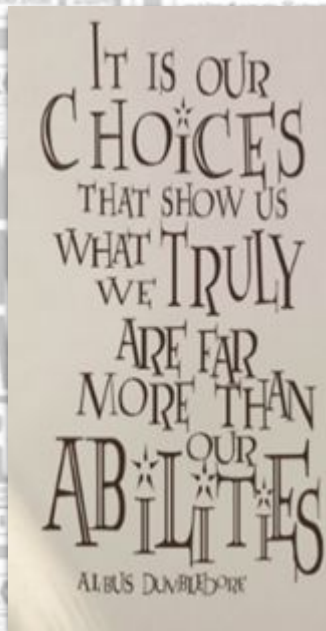


Monthly Prophet:
