During this Lenten Season, we will help your child better understand the meaning of Lent. We will discuss how we can pray, fast, and give alms in special ways during this season. Lent is a special time for families to set aside time for family prayer, attend Sunday Mass, Stations of the Cross, or a weekday Mass. Sharing information about your child with his/her teacher will enable us to provide a learning program that will best meet the needs of your child.

Registration Information for the 2022-2023 school year is included with this parent letter for all students. Please complete one form for each child. You may pay the \$200 registration fee per child in full or in bits if that works best for your family. There is a cap on this fee of \$600 per family for larger families. If you are unable to pay to fee contact the office and we will help you find a sponsor to cover the portion you are unable to pay. **Please return all forms by Thursday, March 31, 2022,** so we can plan for the 2022-2023 school year.

Kindergarten Immunizations are required for all children enrolling in the fall. State immunization laws require children to have a series of three hepatitis B shots, chickenpox immunizations, MMR, DTP, and Polio boosters. **Students will not be admitted the first of school with documentation of immunization proof.**
