

It's hard to believe we only have a few months left of this school year; it's flown by. At the end of the month we'll be having conferences, I'll be sharing how much your child has grown since the beginning of the year - especially in reading.

What We're Learning

Math: We will be moving into a new book and a new unit. We'll work on telling time to the half hour and continue with number stories. We'll be talking about shapes too.

Social Studies: We'll be discussing things in History from our stories, such as the railroad and Jackie Robinson. We'll also talk about people in our community.

Language: We will be talking about verbs (past, present and future) tense and finish the month with compound sentences.
