IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION...Registration for the 2022-2023 school year was due **Thursday, March 31, 2022** for all students K-3rd grade. Please complete one form for each child ASAP so we can plan for the upcoming school year. If you are unable to pay the \$200 registration fee per child in full you may do so later if that works best for your family. There is a cap of \$600 per family for larger families. If you are unable to pay this fee contact the office for assistance with the registration fee.
