

Dear Parents

As we wind down our school, with only two months left, I want to encourage you and your child to keep reading. Remember if your child reads book at home (picture books needs to be read at least three times over at least three days. Chapter books only need to be read once) they may bring them to school and take an AR quiz on that book.

What We're Learning

Math: We will spend most of the month on Unit 8. Learning about building with shapes, half and quarter fractions, putting shapes together and reviewing items that we have done so far this year.

Science: We'll learn about what makes a living and non-living thing. We'll also talk about the different seasons in Reading.

Language: This month, we'll learn about adverbs, transitions and conjunctions, prepositions and phrases, and the use of commas in dates and sentences.

Reading: As we work on our last unit we'll discuss the different seasons and they change what we see, feel and do outside.

Writing: Most of our time on this unit will be spent writing a how-to book. At the end we'll write about which season each student thinks is best and why.
